NOTICE OF RACE

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: Tognazzi Marine Village A.S.D., www.tognazzimv.it, via Litoranea km 10,100 - 00122 Rome - near Villaggio Tognazzi - Phone +39 06.92918150

PLACE AND DATE: Rome - via Litoranea km 10,100 - May 31, June 2 2014.

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, the FIV prescriptions and the Regulations of the class. In case of conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

ELIGIBILITY: The regatta is open to crews of the classes HC 16, HC Wild, HC Tiger, HC Dragoon in good standing with the FIV, medical examination and membership to the Association of class. They will be allowed to participate any foreign crews, with a card of the national Federation to which they belong, if any, and the class card.

ADVERTISING: On the boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. Also may be required to display numbered sticker to be applied on the starboard forecastle and trolley haulage. The individual advertising is regulated by the rules of the class.

REGISTRATION: Pre-registration must be submitted to the Organizing Committee by completing the form provided on the website www.tognazzimv.it. The crew registration must be submitted to the Organizing Committee the registration form, the FIV card (for foreign crews the national Federation card) valid for the current year and complete indication of the medical examination with an expiration date, the certificate of insurance for civil liability of the boat with the minimum cover required by law FIV (€ 1,000,000.00) the advertising certificate and the required fee, if any. Competitors must be in compliance with the class enrollment for the year 2014. These documents must be deposited at the race office at the

time of completion of registration and at least two hours before the start of the first race scheduled.

Children under 18 years will have to deliver the Registration Form signed at the bottom by a parent or by whom, during the event, assumes the responsibility of the racer to get in the water.

ENTRIES: All entries will be completed by 10.00 am on Saturday, May 31, 2014.

The entry fee is € 60.00 for the crews of the class HC Dragoon and € 140.00 for the crews of classes HC 16, HC and HC Wild Tiger. For registration for classes HC 16, HC and HC Wild Tiger made before May 11, 2014, the registration fee is reduced to € 120.00. In this case, the competitors will have to send to the secretary of the club registration forms in enclosing a copy of the bank transfer the balance of the registration fee payable to Tognazzi Marine Village A.S.D. - Credito Valtellinese EU IBAN: IT26N0521603227000000000431 with these information: "Class name, Sailing Number, Sailors name and surname".

SCHEDULE: The regatta will take place in the waters off the Villaggio Tognazzi with the following program:

Friday, May 30

hours 9:00 to 19:00: Registration and distribution sailing instructions

Saturday, May 31

hours 8:00 to 10:00: Registration, distribution sailing instructions

11:00: Skipper meeting

12:00: Warning Signal 1 test, other race to follow

Sunday, June 1

11:00: warning signal for the first race of the day, unless notified to be exposed before 19.00 the previous day.

Monday, June 2

11:00: warning signal for the first race of the day, unless notified that will be exposed before 19.00 the previous day.

Will be played up to 7 races. The series is complete with any number of race runs. No warning signal will be given no later than 17.00 on Monday, June 2, 2014.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available to members before the official opening of the race office.

SCORING: The scoring system is the "Minimum score system" described in Appendix A of the RRS. When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

For the HC Dragoon fleet will be used the Round Robin scoring system. The boats will be provided by the organization. The regatta will be valid as 1 stage of Hobie Cat Dragoon Cup.

PRIZES:

Prizes will be given as follows:

- 1, 2, 3 place HC 16 fleet
- 1, 2, 3 place HC Tiger fleet with more than 10 entries, 1 place with unless 10 entries.
- 1, 2, 3 place HC Wild fleet with more than 10 entries, 1 place with unless 10 entries.
- 1,2,3 place for Dragoon fleet
- 1 place for HC 16 Youth crew
- 1 place for HC 16 women crew.

The national title will be awarded if they were completed at least 4 races and if 10 Italian teams representing at least 4 FIV Zone will be entered (see FIV rules). Foreign crews can not compete for the national title. The crew Hobie Cat 16 which ends first place to the last race will win the Federico Pecorini Trophy.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to define additional special prizes. The prize giving will celebrate as soon as possible after the event.

MEASUREMENTS: Hull, sails, rigging and equipment used during the race will already be measured. The boats will race with the same sail number resulting on the measurement certificate; any changes must be approved in writing by the Race Committee; any checks may be carried out during the days of the regatta. All crews will be weighed at the time of entries and must be in compliance with the rules of the class. Crews under weights will have to set solid weights on the boat.

COACH BOATS: All coaches must be accredited by compiling the registration form available at the race office, stating the characteristics of their coach boat and acceptance of the "rules for boats of assistance Coaches" described in the Sailing Instructions. Coaches and accompanying officers will be subject to disciplinary and technical guidelines of the Race Committee and the Protest Committee may repeal that permission to the presence on the race course. Every coach boat shall be provided with a WHF with channel 72 and 16, will have to display the flag of recognition given by the secretariat and will not bring more than two people on board, one of which under 18 years must wear a life jacket.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Competitors play the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. , Competitors, or person exercising parental authority, are responsible for the decision to take part or to continue the race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta, both on land and in water, as a result of their participation in the race referred to in this Notice of Race. Competitor will decide according to their ability, the strength of the wind, the sea state, weather forecasting, and everything else should be expected from a good sailor, if he go out to sea and take part in the race or to continue it to give up.

PHOTOS RIGHTS AND/OR TELEVISION: Competitors grant full right and permission to the Organizing Committee to publish and / or broadcast media by any means, any photograph or film footage of people or boats during the event, including but not limited to, commercials television and all that they can be used for their editorial or advertising purposes or for printed information.
